#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

Enclosed/attached is a Winter Booking form and a Winter Hoisting/Work Form. Please fill in and return **both** forms as soon as possible. Completion of the former reserves your space for the <u>full</u> winter season, ashore or afloat as appropriate. The timetable for hoisting, positioning of boats ashore, work and launching is prepared from the latter.

We will of course try to carry out your wishes, but not all boats can be hoisted on the 1 November, so please be tolerant if your vessel is still in the water a week or two after arrival. Owners of fin keel boats should discuss cradle requirements when booking space. As a general rule, fin keel boats <u>will</u> require cradles. Your launch date will <u>not</u> be assumed as confirmed from your hoisting/work form (circumstances very often change during the winter months). Please confirm your launch requirements in the Spring giving us at least two weeks notice, and that we possess a cabin key.

#### **CHARGES:-**

Winter Season – up to 7.5mts - £787-50, then £61-43 per half metre (ashore or afloat).

Hoist £24-52 per metre. Blocking off - may be additional time charge.

Launch £23-10 per metre.

High pressure scrub £7-09 per metre.

Unstep/restep masts - minimum £152-00 each way. Handling fee £35-00 minimum.

Waste disposal charge £26-40.

### ALL CHARGES INCLUDE VAT @ 20%.

Electricity: No electrical car hook up is available without prior arrangement

For storage ashore you are welcome to arrive early and/or leave late at extra cost. The full scale of charges and our Terms of Business are displayed around the yard and copies are available upon request. Enquiries for part or extended winter season storage are welcome.

NOTES:

Minimum rate 7.5mts throughout (multihulls surcharge 1/3).

All boats, trailers, cradles, spars and gear, are stored, moored and moved at owners risk. All boats, trailers and cradles <u>must be marked with the parent vessel name and be insured</u>. Under no circumstances are owners permitted to alter/move blocking off timbers or cradle supports. If required please request yard assistance from the office.
